DISCIPLE



Disciple I: Becoming Disciples through Bible Study

- 34-week study
- Covers most of the Bible
- Equal time given to the Old and New Testaments
- Emphasizes the wholeness of the Bible as the revelation of God
- Aims at transformation, not just information

Disciple II: Into the Word Into the World

- 32-week study
- Prerequisite: Disciple I
- Genesis, Exodus, Luke and Acts
- Purpose is to change habits and transform lives

Disciple III: Remember Who You Are

- 32-week study
- Prerequisite: Disciple I
- Old Testament prophets and letters of Paul
- Studies connection between memory and identity as the people of God

Disciple IV: Under the Tree of Life

- 32-week study
- Prerequisite: Disciple I
- Ruth, 1 & 2 Chronicles, Ezra, Nehemiah, Esther, Job, Psalms, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, Song of Solomon, Lamentations, Daniel, John, 1, 2, & 3
- John, James and Revelation
- Word ‘under’ in the title conveys invitation, welcome, shelter, security and rest - home at last

Jesus in the Gospels

- 30-week study
- Prerequisite: Disciple I
- “Who is the Jesus you bring with you to this study?” and “Who is the Jesus you take with you from this study?”
- Focuses on the unique portraits of Jesus found in the four Gospels

Pray In Faith

- 6-week study
- Learn to hear from God in prayer, respond to God through confession, praise, worship and thanksgiving, and join His work through petition and intercession.

Virtuous Woman

- 6-week study
- Course will focus on the relevance of the “ideal woman” in today’s society

- 6-week study
- crafted especially for men
- provides biblical answers for priorities of a winning life

John Wesley on Earning, Saving, and Giving

Small Group Study

- Bi-Monthly, 4-lessons per session
- A biblical understanding of the relationship between a follower of Christ and the use of his or her financial resources.
- Affirms the positive use of money and challenges some of our common assumptions and invite students into prayerful consideration of the way their lifestyle reflects their identity as disciples of Jesus Christ
- Think more deeply about the use of money in a positive Christ-centered fashion

- Practical application to health and fitness
- A reminder of our connectedness to creation
